Sun 8 th Oct 3pm Classical Music	The Schubert Sessions – Schubert 1827 Series - Concert 1: The opening concert in a series of three full-length classical recitals of some of Schuberts' most iconic and celebrated compositions from 1827. This opening concert performed by Dr Fionnuala Moynihan will feature both sets of Impromptus for solo piano.
Thur 12 th Oct Jazz	The Whistling Girl – Honor Heffernan & Trevor Knight Acclaimed Jazz singer/actress Honor Heffernan with composer Trevor Knight present a new cabaret/speakeasy style show transforming poems by Dorothy Parker into songs, creating a darkly sardonic body of work in which the American wit and critic's poetry is transported into the 21st century. The Whistling Girl gives Dorothy's poetry a sonic face-lift fusing 'dirty'-cabaret, electronic-vaudeville, rock and jazz, combined with underscored original recordings of Parker's voice.
Sat 14 th Oct Drama	Down & Out in Paris and London - Odyssey George Orwell's classic book is brought to life on the stage by Phelim Drew. It tells the story of a man drifting through life in 1920s Paris, scraping by in dead-end jobs and generally soaking up the rich underbelly of Parisian life, finding himself falling helplessly short and discovering a very different view of life, looking up from below. With a keen understanding of social inequality and a wry sense of humour, he vividly recounts his experiences while down and out.
Wed 18 th Oct Classical Music	Tine Thing Helseth Tour The Music Network brings a rare opportunity to experience the sound of the trumpet with Norway's internationally renowned trumpet star, Tine Helseth. On a mission to expand the performance repertoire for solo trumpet, Tine Helseth commissioned new works from dozens of composers and is now recognised as one of the world's leading trumpet soloists, with a slew of awards to her name and widespread critical acclaim for her clean, open sound, flawless technique and soulful phrasing.
Fri 20 th Oct Comedy/Drama	Drinking in America Award winning play by US playwright Eric Bogosian. This show has been described by the New York Times as "a breakneck, hair-raising comic tour of the contemporary American male psyche". It features acclaimed actor Liam O'Brien playing 12 distinct different roles accompanied by Choice prize nominated musician Steve Ryan who provides a live soundtrack to the production.
